Connecting your Maverick/Maverick2 **Immersive Entertainment System**

Wireless Pairing

Before you begin, make sure your TV supports pairing with wireless speakers or audio devices. (Your TV's wireless connection should be version 5.0 or higher.) Have your owner's manual handy or look up online how to connect a wireless speaker to make the process smoother.

1. Power On Your Audio System: Power Turn on your furniture's audio system by finding the power ON/OFF button. PRESS AND HOLD it until the LED lights turn on or you hear a voice say "POWER ON" (if using the wireless remote).

2. Enter Pairing Mode: If you have more than one piece of furniture, you only need to pair one with your TV. Choose the one you'll be sitting in most

On that main piece of your furniture, find the wireless pairing button. PRESS AND HOLD it until the small blue light starts flashing. This means it's ready to pair.

Location of the wireless pairing button:














3. Pair with TV: Check your TV's settings menu to find where you can add a wireless audio device. Since every TV is different, you may need your manual or a quick online search for your specific model.

Look for these device names when pairing:

- Moto **Immersive Audio**
- Moto **Media System**
- Moto Audio



If our devices are not found, please ensure that your Moto Amplifier is in AUX mode.




4. Activate Broadcast Mode: Once you've paired with the Moto Media System, make sure the TV's sound is set to use this device. The light on your furniture will stay solid blue when connected. *Pro tip: Crank the volume up past 90% with your TV remote almost to max for the best sound. Then try playing something to test it.

If you have more than one piece of furniture, here's the cool part: use **Broadcast Mode**. Start with the piece already paired to the TV. On that same pairing button, QUICKLY DOUBLE TAP until you hear "broadcast mode" through the speakers. The light will turn from blue to SOLID PURPLE.


Now, turn on the audio system on your other furniture pieces. On each, quickly double tap the pairing button until you hear "broadcast mode." Their lights will glow SOLID RED when they're linked.


SPDIF Digital Optical Cable(s) Connection

- (1) 3.5mm Female AUX Jack to 2-RCA Adapter
- 11) 25ft Male-to-Male 3.5mm AUX Cable
- (2) 10ft Male-to-Male 3.5mm AUX Cable





3. If you are connecting multiple Moto pieces using the SPDIF cables, you also need to purchase an optical splitter*.

*Connect the digital optical splitter to your audio source and run seperate optical cables to each unit.







RCA Audio Cable(s) Connection








3. To connect multiple Moto products, first connect the RCA to 3.5mm AUX adapter to your audio source.

Then, plug the 3.5mm auxiliary cable into the AUX input port on the first product.

Next, plug a second 3.5mm auxiliary cable into the AUX output port of the first product and into the AUX input port of the next one.
